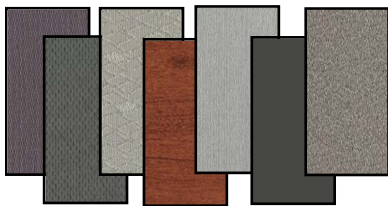

Staffers at a life insurance company had been working in the same furniture for many years. When their restructuring called for an updated new look in their HQ offices, Terrace was a smart choice for a more effective and expressive use of their space.



Reasons for Success

Attempting to maximize the amount of space a company occupies can be challenging, but it is even more so when a building has an unusual shape. Their round office building meant the Allsteel dealer had to come up with a unique plan to

optimize every inch of space. To help incorporate more functionality into the work environment, managers throughout the insurance company were interviewed to determine each department's function and unique work space needs. The result was 8' x 8' workstations for staff and 8' x 12' for management that included freestanding storage with three files, bookcase, as well as mobile pedestals. The solution not only maximized the amount of filing space, but also kept files in close proximity to the teams requiring them. In addition, Terrace's material versatility allowed them to create a much more vibrant and expressive environment than they could have imaged.



To reduce installation interruptions in each department, an Allsteel project manager provided a phased project schedule and assisted to assure complete and on-time delivery and installation.

The employees give their new workstations rave reviews, which
