### **U.S. Patents**

The "Folding and Tilting Table" patent was recently issued by the United States Patent and Trademark Office for the dual-motion Get Set table. This patent recognizes the innovation that allows the table to be easily transformed from a working position to a vertical position for nesting or to a folded position for storage.

Because of the ease of reconfiguration and storage, the dual-motion Get Set table increases space efficiency, provides flexibility and reduces room reconfiguration time. Lightweight by design and featuring intuitive controls, it enables nearly anyone to rearrange the room.

The "Hanging Markerboard Swivel Hook" patent was issued to recognize a component of the wall board, one of the presentation tools in the Get Set collection. The Get Set wall board is hung on a rail by two hooks that rotate. The hooks allow the user to conveniently flip the board for increased note-taking space or to span a corner, creating a useful area from an often unutilized space.

**NADCA Award**

Allsteel's Get Set was also honored for the innovative design of its Nesting Latch casting by the NADCA. The Nesting Latch was the winner in the Aluminum Die Casting Under 1 lb. category in the CastExpo '05 competition.
