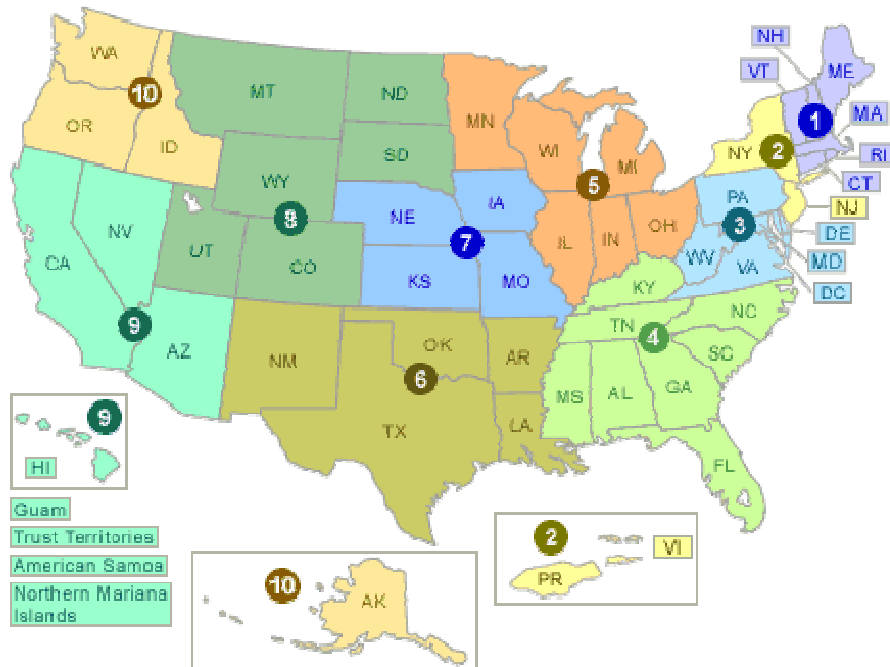

Other Recycling Guidance

Steel Recycling Opportunities

The Steel Recycling Institute maintains a database of over 30,000 facilities that accept steel for recycling. Their searchable database is at www.recycle-steel.org/cgi-bin/sridbq3.pl.

Aluminum Recycling Opportunities

Non-ferrous material processors are located throughout the United States. Go to the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries' Member Directory at www.isri.org. In the top-left corner under their logo, click the yellow "Member Directory" button and search by various criteria offered.

Plastic Recycling Opportunities

The number of plastic recycling facilities is increasing, as is the variety of plastics they will accept. One option is to go to www.earth911.com and use their recycling database, which consists mostly of the more common consumer plastics taken by municipalities. There are private companies who will accept all plastics for recycling, such as Vikoz Enterprises, General Mill Supply, and PlastiCycle (found through internet search), although Allsteel does not endorse any private company.
